


Your Fence Post Carrier Kit is exclusively designed for your vehicle. Please read the installation instructions thoroughly before beginning. Installation is easier if the vehicle is clean and free of debris. For your safety, and to ensure a satisfactory installation, perform all installation steps correctly in the sequence shown.


Approximately 10-15 minutes

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Shift vehicle transmission into "PARK". Turn key to "OFF" position and remove from vehicle.
- 2. If Rear Brushguard Kit (PN 2878840, sold separately) is installed, then proceed to Step 3. Otherwise, install support ① to vehicle frame using four each screws ② and nuts ③ as shown.




3. Insert lower frame ① into vehicle receiver, then secure using hitch pin ③ and hairpin clip ④ as shown.




4. Attach lower frame ① to support ⑪ or rear brushguard, as applicable, using two quick release pins ⑤ as shown.

NOTE

Illustration shows attachment to rear brushguard. Attachment to support (1) similar except pins pass through holes in support.




5. Insert upper frame ② into lower frame ①, then secure using four each screws ⑭ and nuts ③ as shown.



6. Install strap **(6)** to upper frame **(2)** using screw **(7)** and nut **(8)** as shown.

IMPORTANT

Strap is used to minimize post vibration during transport. Strap is NOT intended to retain posts during transport. Retainer rod (9), installed in next step, provides post retention.



7. After inserting fence posts in carrier install retainer rod (9) as far forward as possible, then secure using two hairpin clips (10) as shown.

Wrap strap **6** around posts, then secure to hook **A**.

IMPORTANT

Maximum Capacity: 12 fence posts

NOTE

Four retainer rod positions available; rear position shown.
